Contaminated food can sicken pets and humans who handle it. Symptoms of Salmonella are mainly vomiting and diarrhea. If your cat may have eaten the contaminated food and you notice any noticeable changes in their activity, a visit to your veterinary is recommended to start symptomatic treatment and antibiotics.
