Bravo, a company that specializes in raw pet food, has recalled <u>turkey and chicken foods for cats</u> <u>and dogs due to salmonella.</u> The bacteria can harm pets and people handling the food.

## **Recalled foods:**

- 1. Raw Turkey Blend for cats and dogs (2lb. package with best used by date of 11/05/15.)
- 2. <u>All Natural Chicken Blend for cats and dogs</u> (2lb. package with best used by date of 8/11/16.)
- Raw Premium Turkey Balance Formula
   (5lb. package with best used date of 11/5/15.)
- 4. <u>All Natural Chicken Blend diet for cats and dogs</u> (5lb. package with best used by date of 8/11/16.)







The foods were sold nationwide starting November. 12, 2013. If you have any of these products, dispose of them immediately.

## Symptoms of Salmonella poisoning in your pet can include:

- Diarrhea that might contain blood or mucus
- Fatigue/tiredness
- Fever
- Vomiting
- Decreased appetite
- Excess salivation

Cats and dogs can have *Salmonella* infection and not appear sick. If your cat or dog has any of these signs of illness – or has consumed the above foods – contact your veterinarian immediately. Let your veterinarian know that your pet has consumed a recalled food.
