## Oma's Pride foods SALMONELLA recall

Oma's Pride of Avon, CT is recalling Purr-Complete Feline Poultry Meal because it has the potential to be contaminated with *Salmonella*. *Salmonella* can affect animals eating the products and there is risk to humans from handling contaminated pet products, especially if they have not thoroughly washed their hands after having contact with the products or any surfaces exposed to these products.

### Recalled foods:

#### Purr-Complete Feline Poultry Meal

Packaged frozen in clear plastic packaging under the Oma's Pride brand as a poultry blend with code #1524.

- 12 oz. (UPC: 8 79384 00017 9)
- 2 lb. (UPC: 8 79384 00018 6)
- Manufactured on September 12, 2014
- Use by recommended date of September 12, 2015.

The foods were sold nationwide starting November. 12, 2013. If you have any of these products, dispose of them immediately.



### Symptoms of Salmonella poisoning in your pet can include:

- Diarrhea that might contain blood or mucus
- Fatigue/ tiredness
- Fever
- Vomiting
- Decreased appetite
- Excess salivation

Cats can have *Salmonella* infection and not appear sick. If your cat has any of these signs of illness – or has consumed the above foods – contact your veterinarian immediately. Let your veterinarian know that your pet has consumed a recalled food.
