Change in Cat Food Formula Could Affect Feline Health

Recently, Wellness Pet Food changed the label of its canned cat food. **It also changed the INGREDIENTS.** The affected product is now named "Wellness Health™ Pate" (pictured).

Some cats can do fine with such changes. However many cats – finicky eaters to begin with, with sensitive GI tracts – can have serious reactions to dietary changes.

If you use Wellness food – or are considering making ANY changes to your cat's diet -- watch for the following:

- Diarrhea / loose stool
- Vomiting
- Aversion to eating

If you notice any of the above, contact your veterinarian immediately. He or she may suggest a diet change.

IMPORTANT NOTE: If your cat exhibits any of the above symptoms AT ANY TIME, see your veterinarian immediately as any of these could be signs of serious illness.
